### **Classification Description**

**CLASSIFICATION TITLE:** Streets Technician  
**FUNCTIONAL AREA:** Public Works Department

---

#### **WORK OBJECTIVE:**

Under general supervision, the purpose of the position is to perform a wide variety of semi-skilled maintenance and repair work in skilled trade disciplines, e.g., masonry, carpentry. Employees in this classification perform all work according to established safety standards, codes and regulations applicable to the work. Employees in this classification have previous experience in the trade, and can perform tasks independently, though work remains subject to review and inspection during and upon completion of assigned tasks.

#### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

The list of essential functions, as outlined herein, is intended to be representative of the tasks performed within this classification. It is not necessarily descriptive of any one position in the class. The omission of an essential function does not preclude management from assigning duties not listed herein if such functions are a logical assignment to the position.

- Performs routine to moderately complex maintenance and repairs on structures, facilities, equipment, streets, sidewalks, bicycle paths and other City property in skilled trade disciplines, e.g., masonry, carpentry, stucco.
- Assists in the construction of new building and recreational facilities, e.g., restrooms, ADA ramps, baseball dugouts, dumpster enclosures, pavilions, playground areas, drainage systems.
- Maintains and repairs concrete valley gutters and catch basins and curbing.
- Performs general maintenance, replacement tasks and repairs to facilities, storm water and drainage systems.
- Loads, transports and distributes various materials such as gravel and sand to level and fill public grounds.
- Constructs water meter and pump vaults for Utilities Division.
- Assists with emergency preparedness and response.

#### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

##### **Education / Certifications / Experience –**

High school diploma or GED; supplemented by five (5) to seven (7) years experience in semi-skilled laboring or maintenance work; or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience. Must possess and maintain a valid Class "B" Florida Commercial Drivers License. Must acquire DOT Work Zone Safety Certification Intermediate Level within one year of employment.

## Streets Technician

### Knowledge, Skills, & Abilities –

General knowledge of the methods, tools, equipment and necessary safety precautions used in general maintenance and repair work.

Knowledge of current codes and regulatory standards governing streets and drainage construction and maintenance.

Ability to understand and follow written and oral instructions.

Ability to read and write English.

Ability to operate basic office equipment, e.g., computer terminals, printers, copy machines, telephone systems, facsimile machines.

Ability to operate basic manual and electric hand tools, e.g., hammer, screwdriver, saw, power drill, masonry tools.

Ability to operate heavy equipment and machinery, e.g., dumptruck, pickup truck, one and three ton roller, skid loader.

### PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Tasks involve the intermittent performance of physically demanding work, typically involving some combination of reaching, bending, stooping, kneeling, or crouching, and that may involve the lifting, carrying, pushing, and/or pulling of moderately heavy objects and materials (20-50 pounds). Requires intermittent lifting, carrying, pushing, and/or pulling of heavier objects (100+ pounds).

### ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS:

Most tasks are performed in an outdoor environment with potential for exposure to disagreeable elements, e.g., heat, humidity, toxic agents. Tasks include working around moving parts, equipment, carts, and materials handling where physical risks are predictable/controllable by observance of standard safety precautions. Some tasks are performed in a shop environment, where heightened awareness to surroundings and observance of established safety precautions is essential in avoidance of injury or accidents.
