




Parks & Recreation

The City of Coral Springs offers a rich variety of youth, adult and senior programs throughout the year.

Family and teen concerts, Movies in the Park, a Skate Park, special needs activities, roller hockey at Riverside Park, summer Kamp Kool programs, after school and FunDay programs, senior activities, and more than 675 acres of parks are waiting for you and for your family!



Regional Park

8/9. Sportsplex at Coral Springs, located between Royal Palm Boulevard and Sample Road on Sportsplex Drive - 180.8 acres includes the world-class Coral Springs Aquatic Complex, Tennis Center of Coral Springs, Saveology.com Iceplex, Sawgrass Nature Center & Wildlife Hospital, Dr. Steven G. Paul Dog Park as well as 16 tennis courts, 4 swimming pools (including 1 diving pool), playground, jog/walk trail, picnic tables, 2 meeting rooms, 1 maintenance building, 2 storage facilities, and 3 restrooms.

Community Parks

11. Mullins Park, 10000 Ben Geiger Dr. - A second home to many local families involved in City sports, Mullins is the largest park in Coral Springs. Facilities include basketball courts, tennis courts, swimming pool, volleyball courts, picnic pavilions, as well as soccer, baseball, softball, and artificial turf football fields. Mullins Park is a center of activity for sports leagues and outdoor activities throughout the year.

22. Cypress Park, 1301 Coral Springs Drive - Best known for the 5 baseball fields and 4 soccer fields (2 of which are artificial grass). The basketball courts, sand volleyball court, playground, and fitness track have also become popular forms of exercise and outdoor activity for residents of all ages.

31/35. North Community Park, 5601 Coral Springs Drive - 38.06 acres, includes baseball and soccer fields, tennis courts, sand volleyball courts, 2 half basketball courts, playground, picnic pavilion, and a walking/jogging path.

Sports Leagues

Coral Springs boasts a thriving sports league program for kids and adults. Whether you want to learn or just have fun, there are year-round opportunities in the following sports:

3. Betti Stradling, 10301 Wiles Road - 21 acres, Skate Park, Slide & Glide playground, 3 athletic fields, 2 basketball courts, 2 sand volleyball courts, 2 picnic pavilions, exercise stations, 1-mile asphalt walking/jogging path and large open play area

4. Windings, 3795 N.W. 108th Drive - 6 acres, natural setting, playground

5. Chevy Chase North, 4230 N.W. 106th Avenue - 7 acres, natural setting

6. Castlewood, 3800 N.W. 115th Avenue - 4 acres, half-court basketball, playground, grills & tables, pavilion

7. Shadowwood, 9350 S.W. 1st Place - 2 acres, natural setting

10. Three Friends, 11900 N.W. 30th Street - 5 acres, natural setting

12. Forest Hills, 2500 Forest Hills Boulevard - 7 acres, lacrosse/baseball/softball fields, playground, pavilion, tables, restrooms, tennis court, volleyball court, half basketball court

13. Sherwood Forest, 1600 N.W. 91st Avenue - 29 acres, volleyball court, horseshoe pit, playground, bocce ball, nature area, jog/walk trail, grills & tables, 3 picnic pavilions, restrooms

14. Kiwanis, 520 Ramblewood Drive - 11 acres, playground, nature area, jog/walk trail, grills & tables, meeting room, restrooms

15. 3 Mountains Natural Area, 9200 N.W. 1st Street - 21 acres, natural setting, playground


16. Oakwood, 10284 S.W. 1st Court - 7 acres, playground, picnic pavilion, walking/jogging path, open play area

24. Riverside, 205 Coral Ridge Drive - 15 acres, 3 basketball courts, 4 volleyball courts, playground, nature area, jog/walk trail, boat ramp, 3 roller hockey rinks, grills & tables, picnic pavilion, restrooms

25. Veterans, 8601 Royal Palm Blvd. - 7 acres, 2 tennis courts, grills & table

30. Lakeview, 11501 Lakeview Drive - 7 acres, sand volleyball court, playground, picnic pavilion, walking/jogging path

32. Jaycee, 4800 Riverside Drive - 10 acres, baseball/softball field, tennis court, basketball court, playground, grills & tables, picnic pavilion, restrooms

36. Paul Britton, 11400 Wyndham Lakes Blvd. North - 4 acres, 2 basketball courts, open play area, playground, picnic pavilion

40. Fern Glen, 4801 N.W. 66th Terrace - 18 acres, half basketball court, volleyball court, playground, bocce ball court, nature area, jog/walk trail, grills & tables, picnic pavilion, restrooms

41/42. Volunteer, 5000 Creekside Drive - 16.32 acres, natural setting, walking path, playground, tennis court, half basketball court, volleyball court, 2 picnic pavilions, open play area, restrooms
