What is SwimAmerica?

SwimAmerica is the learn-to-swim program of the American Swimming Coaches Association. The program is taught in 10 stations. Every student progresses at his or her own rate, independent of other students' development. Safety is the main reason for learning to swim. The SwimAmerica learn-to-swim program will give your child a safe start in life! The coaches are gentle, responsible, understanding and are all certified by the American Swimming Coaches Association.

What will your child learn in the SwimAmerica Program?

SwimAmerica teaches much more than just how to swim. We emphasize proper techniques of swimming and give special care to correct breathing, body position, and good swimming strokes. The program teaches all four strokes, starts and turns, and is an excellent preparation for swimmers that would like to join the swim team. Proficiency leads to **achievement** and **self esteem**. SwimAmerica teaches the best skills for a lifetime of **safety, fun and fitness!**

What will your child have to bring to class?

Swimsuit, towel, swim cap (required for girls). Goggles are optional, but helpful. Both goggles and caps can be purchased at the first class at the Swimshop in the Coral Springs Aquatic Complex. **Please do not have your child eat 45 minutes prior to class.**

Make-up and Cancellation Policy - Please Read Carefully!

If your child is unable to attend a class, please give us 24 hours notice and call 954-345-5441 to schedule a free make-up lesson. Please understand that **ONLY ONE** free make-up lesson is awarded per session, and must be taken prior to the end of the session. Further make-ups can be scheduled for an extra charge. SwimAmerica will not give any refunds for classes missed. If a class is cancelled due to weather conditions, you can call our office to re-schedule. Classes are generally cancelled only for thunderstorms; we will teach when it is raining. To find out whether classes are being held on a particular day during bad weather, please call the Aquatic Complex at 954-345-2121, since our staff will be at the pool and not in our office.

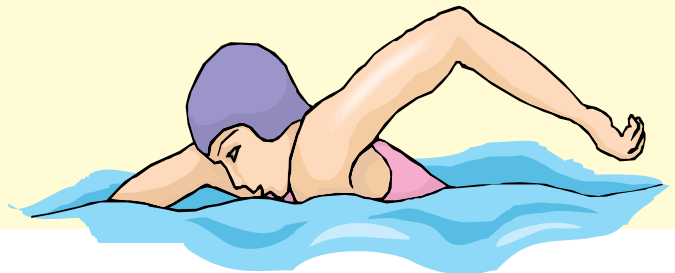
