MusicMakers! Summer Camp is an innovative exploration of musical possibilities, with strong emphasis on singing, playing instruments, choreography, and music theory and history. MusicMakers! exposes children ages 6 to 14 to a wide variety of musical styles. Basic and advanced instruction is available for every camper in healthy singing techniques, strings, percussion, keyboard and recorder. Campers of all levels of musical experience are welcome. Participants are grouped by age and/or experience. Free recitals and finale concerts open to the public are presented during each session. Costumes are required for productions and may involve a nominal additional charge. A limited number of partial scholarships are available. Volunteer counselor applications are due by May 1 (must have completed ninth grade).

Registration Fee: \$20 per child per session; cash only; must be paid to camp director at orientation on June 12. Also, additional cost for soprano recorder (\$8), study book (\$7) and pizza lunch additional (\$6 per Friday); must also be prepaid in cash at orientation.
