

Summer Camp Important Dates To Remember

Monday, March 23

Mail-in registration begins for eight-week Kamp Kool programs.

Tuesday, April 1

Begin accepting balance payments at all Parks and Recreation offices.

Thursday, April 9

Begin accepting registration for four-week Kamp Kool sessions (as space allows) and walk-ins for eight-week sessions.

Wednesday, May 6

Last day to pay balances due on all camps.

Thursday, June 4

Last day of public school/early release.

June 8 to 12

Mini-Camp begins at Cypress Park.

Friday, June 12

Kamp Kool Open House from 6 to 8 p.m. at respective camp sites.

Monday, June 15

Kamp Kool Begins.

Friday, July 3

No camp, Fourth of July Holiday.

Friday, August 7

Last day of eight-week program.

Monday, August 10

First day of extension camp.

Friday, August 14

Last day of extension camp.

Monday, August 24

First day of public school (tentative).



- Drowning is the **leading** cause of death in children under five years of age in Florida.
- For every 1 child who drowns, 4 children are admitted for near drowning and 14 are seen and discharged from the emergency department.
- In the case of in pool drownings, 77 percent of the children who drowned had been seen five minutes or less before being missed and subsequently found in the pool.
