

EMERGENCY ORDER 2020-18

**EXTENDING EMERGENCY ORDER 2020-07 RE: THE CONTINUATION OF ALL
NON-HEALTH AND SAFETY SPECIAL MAGISTRATE HEARINGS AND
COMPLIANCE DATES**

On March 13, 2020 a State of Emergency was declared in the City of Coral Springs relating to the Novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 (“COVID-19”).

Pursuant to Section 252.46, *Florida Statutes* and Chapter 19 of the Code of the City of Coral Springs, the City has the power to issue emergency orders with the force of law. The City Manager has expressly been authorized to issue Emergency Orders.

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the March 19, 2020 Order, 2020-07, continuing all Special Magistrate hearings and compliance dates other than hearings and compliance dates for health and safety violations is hereby extended to September 1, 2020.

This Emergency Order is effective immediately.
