

Public Art in Coral Springs

Tax dollars are not used to purchase public art in Coral Springs. All financing comes from a fee charged to developers who have projects greater than 12,500 square feet. Since 2004, eighteen sculptures have been purchased for permanent display in the City of Coral Springs through the Public Art Fund.

Developers may contribute to the Public Art Fund or purchase an artwork to display on their property in accordance with Chapter 6 of the the City of Coral Springs Land Development Code. Two developments have completed this process. Guardian Towers Moon, Sun, Fire by Gustavo Vejarano was installed by H&M Development at the Whispering Woods Center on Wiles Road and Tropical Toss by Kim Radochia was installed by Symphony Builders at Village Green Apartments on Sample Road.



The ArtWalk is much more than an attractive pedestrian-friendly environment in the Downtown Coral Springs area. The City has plans to make it a vibrant and bustling area where there will be multiple community events for all to enjoy. The City, along with the Coral Springs Chamber of Commerce, will be planning monthly events at the ArtWalk, in addition to the new Coral Springs Farmers' Market!

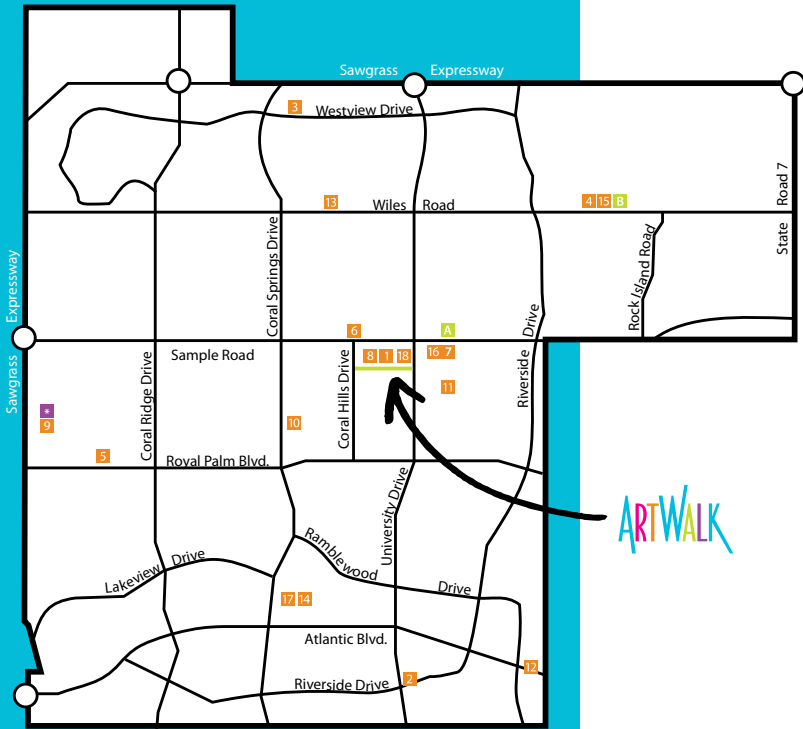
